Watchers of the Sky is a powerful feature documentary that exposes the uncanny parallels of genocides across time and culture. Uniquely, Watchers of the Sky tells the stories of five remarkable people who are trying to end the international community's political paralysis and make "never again" a reality. These individuals' actions and choices demonstrate that people can effectively challenge the axiom that nothing can be done to end genocide.

ABOUT THE FILM'S CHARACTERS

Watchers of the Sky follows multiple stories, each of them opening a different window onto the atrocities of genocide, and shows the accumulative power of individuals to transform the world from apathy to action.

Raphael Lemkin—the man who created the word 'genocide' and first brought the world's attention to the moral imperative of addressing it.

Emmanuel Uvvueukun — a Rwandan aid worker who is himself a genocide survivor, runs three refugee camps housing Darfuri refugees in Chad.

Benjamin Ferencz — at 90 one of the last surviving prosecutors from the Nuremberg Trials, will not be silenced as he persistently cajoles delegates at the United Nations to take action.

Luis Moreno-Ocampo — Chief Prosecutor at the International Criminal Court in The Hague, who begins proceedings against the Sudanese Government on charges of genocide and crimes against humanity.

Samantha Power — author of the Pulitzer Prize-winning examination of genocide "A Problem From Hell," whose insightful and articulate voice ties these disparate stories together to connect the events in Sudan with the unfulfilled legacy of Raphael Lemkin.

Power, Ferencz, Uvvueukun and Moreno-Ocampo, work in different corners of the globe but with a unity of purpose. They bear Raphael Lemkin's torch today.

HOW WILL WATCHERS OF THE SKY MAKE A DIFFERENCE?

Using the powerful stories of the film's main characters, and the galvanizing effect of film, *Watchers of the Sky* will create a community committed to ending violence through education and advocacy.

Watchers of the Sky will serve as a catalyst to engage audiences in understanding how individuals can impact change and be a voice for the forgotten faces of injustice and violence. Each day individuals from different socioeconomic classes, geographies, religions, ethnicities and cultures fall victim to violence, whether it is genocide, human rights abuses, rape or even common bullying. The horror of violence and its consequences know no boundaries.
